Bring your class to the heart of Armadale for a free curriculum-linked museum program. Our engaging, hands-on sessions can be adapted, but are linked to the the curriculum of recommended year levels.

Our programs include:

- **Our Pioneers**

(Years 1 - 3)

Come to our Museum to discover more about pioneer life, old fashioned school lessons and traditional games.

A heritage walk is also available for Years 2 – 3.

- **Nidja Noongar Boodjar (Here is Aboriginal Country)**

(Cross Curricular Years 1 - 6)

Discover Noongar culture through the six seasons, artefacts, bush tucker, stories, language, outdoor exploration and art.

- **World at War Armadale**

(Years 2 - 3)

Explore local wartime stories through Memorial Park, museum displays and historical objects. Learn why we remember those who served.

- **Local Government**

(City of Armadale schools only, Years 4 - 6)

Explore the role of local government through historical objects, stories and a visit to the Council Chambers, where students can meet the Mayor or a Councillor and role-play how community ideas become reality.

Important information:

- Programs run during school hours (full or half day by request).
- Maximum of two classes per day.
- Supervision ratio: 1 adult to 6 students.
