Brain Bags

Brain bags are a fun way for children to build and develop essential skills. Each blue bag has a different theme including: reading and writing, fractions, money, basic equations, measurement, shapes and patterns, and time.

These kits contain books, educational toys and suggested activities that suit a range of skill levels among primary school aged children.

Brain bags may be borrowed by all library members, and are available from all three branches.

Armadale Library has an exciting range of puppets for loan including: fairy tale characters, birds, animals and mythological creatures. All three libraries have a range of children's jigsaws for loan.

Chatterbooks

Chatterbooks were developed by speech therapists to encourage your child's speech and language skills.

Each book comes with a range of free, fun and creative activity sheets for you to use at home. Eight titles are currently available at all of our libraries, including: *Big Rain Coming*, *Rosie's Walk* and *Owl Babies*.

Story Bags, Discovery and Deadly Backpacks

Backpacks contain a variety of items, such as books, puppets, CDs, DVDs, games, felt/magnet boards, musical instruments and activities – all intended to encourage families to engage with literacy and storytelling at home.

Themes include: Indigenous, measuring, directions, numbers, transport, animals, farms, bugs, fairytales, nursery rhymes, music, dinosaurs and unicorns.

Yellow backpacks

These are designed for families with a child aged two to three years.

Green backpacks

These are designed for families with a child aged four to five years.

Blue backpacks

These are filled with exciting storytelling resources as well as brain bags.

Deadly backpacks

These feature Noongar language, stories and culture.
