This free resource consists of a choice of loan boxes with themed items that students and teachers can explore, interact and play with. These boxes can be loaned out for up to two weeks and will be delivered to and collected from local schools by History House Museum staff. The following boxes are available:

At the Shops - Shops have seen a lot of change over the years, and these objects will help demonstrate just how much.

Domestic Life - Reflect on a range of items that were common place in house holds of the past.

On the Farm - Farming was a common employment of early Armadale settlers. This collection includes a range of objects those farmers would have needed.

Toys - Without the availability of technology and the internet, toys and games of the 'olden days' were creative, usually simple and still a lot of fun.

Transport & Tools - A collection of items that reflect the early transport and trade professions.
